- Make up some Gelli in any bowl or container.
- Open up a large zip lock bag, and fill approximately half full.
- Seal it back up, and flatten out the bag to spread the Gelli.

PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USE!

Measure your water!

In a bowl:

- For <u>fluffy</u> Gelli we recommend starting with around 1 Litre per 25g of powder.
- For <u>squishy</u> Gelli, start with 2 Litres of water per 25g of powder.

THE MORE WATER YOU ADD,
THE THINNER THE GELLI WILL BE!

In a bath tub:

- Start with around **4cm** of water (20 Litres) in a standard size bath tub.
- After you've added your **STEP 1** powder and the Gelli has formed, you can then add more water to thin it out

Water should <u>not</u> exceed 8cm! (40 Litres)

FOR USE IN A BOWL

STEP I: MAKE YOUR GELLI

- 1. Start by filling a bowl or container with warm water, following the Measure your water instructions. DO NOT USE BOILING WATER.
- 2. Measure out 25g of STEP 1 Gelli powder, and slowly and evenly sprinkle over the surface of the water, and stir occasionally with a large spoon or spatula. To avoid possible staining, do not let skin come in contact with powder prior to adding water or Gelli forming. The longer you mix it, the thicker it will get.
- 3. Once the Gelli is fully formed, you can then add more water to thin it out. Do not exceed 5 Litres per 25g of powder!

Why not try adding some dinosaur figures to create a prehistoric sensory tub?

Please note: Once a bag has been opened, we recommend storing in a dry, airtight container until next use.

STEP 2: DISPOSE OF YOUR GELLI

Please note: This should be done by an adult.

- When you're finished, you can evenly sprinkle some of the **STEP 2** powder over the Gelli, to help dissolve it into a drainable liquid. If you're using Gelli Baff Colour Change, watch as the Gelli magically changes colour!
- 2. The water will remain coloured, but the Gelli will be thinner and can easily be drained away. Carefully pour your Gelli down the toilet and flush.

Gelli Baff is certified bio-degradable and when diluted, will not block toilets.

3. Rinse your container in the sink, to remove any excess Gelli.

FOR USE IN A BATH TUB



STEP 1: MAKE YOUR GELLI

Run your warm water tap as you would usually, but following the **Measure your water** instructions.

Please note: Water should not exceed 8cm (40 Litres)

- **2.** Gently sprinkle **150g** of **STEP 1** Gelli powder **slowly and evenly** over the surface of the water, and stir with your hands. The longer you mix it, the thicker it will get.
- **3.** Gelli <u>will not</u> reach it's maximum thickness for 10-15 minutes. Once the Gelli is fully formed, you can then add more water to thin it out. Take care when getting in the bath, as Gelli is very slippery.

STEP 2: DISPOSE OF YOUR GELLI

Please note: This should be done by an adult.

- When you're finished, evenly sprinkle STEP 2 powder over the Gelli Baff, and stir thoroughly with your hand, to help dissolve it into a drainable liquid. If you're using Gelli Baff Colour Change, watch as the Gelli magically changes colour!
- 2. The water will remain coloured, but the Gelli will be thinner and can easily be drained away. Don't worry if you think your Gelli Baff hasn't dissolved enough and you've run out of STEP 2 powder. Simply add some salt, and more water to dissolve what's left. Then simply pull the plug!

Gelli Baff is certified bio-degradable and when diluted, will not block drains. However if you have existing issues with (slow) drainage, we recommend disposing of the Gelli down the toilet.

3. Stay sat down, and rinse away any excess Gelli. Take care when getting out of the bath, as Gelli is very slippery.

FOR TABLE-TOP MODELLING

STEP 1: MAKE YOUR GELLI

- 1. Start by filling a bowl with 2 Litres of warm water. DO NOT USE BOILING WATER.
- **2.** Measure out **25g** of **STEP 1** Gelli powder, **slowly and evenly** sprinkle over the surface of the water, and stir occasionally with a large spoon or spatula. To avoid possible staining, do not let skin come in contact with powder prior to adding water or Gelli forming.
- 3. Leave the Gelli for 30 minutes, until it reaches a mouldable consistency.
- 4. Time to get creative! Use the Gelli to mould shapes, characters or even

Why not use cookie cutters to easily cut out and mould fun shapes?

Please note: Once a bag has been opened, we recommend storing in a dry, airtight container until next use.

STEP 2: DISPOSE OF YOUR GELLI

Please note: This should be done by an adult.

- When you're finished, gather all the Gelli together and evenly sprinkle some of the **STEP 2** powder over the Gelli to help dissolve it into a drainable liquid. This should be done in a bowl or bucket.
- 2. The water will remain coloured, but the Gelli will be thinner and can easily be drained away. Carefully pour your Gelli down the toilet and flush.

Gelli Baff is certified bio-degradable and when diluted, will not block toilets.

3. Rinse your container in the sink, to remove any excess Gelli.
